Item	Detail
Core works (original quote)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Site establishment• Clean existing track and dispose of all waste material off site.• Apply weed kill application to track.• Remove track damage to perimeter and replace with new.• Remove provisional 50.00m² of damage track and replace with new (to be confirmed once cleaned).• Replace track from long jump area and replace with new.• Apply new spray coat to entire area.• Install new line marking to match existing layout.• Clean and tidy site prior to leaving.
Long jump/Triple Jump	Triple jump at one end with 5m, 7m, 9m and 11m boards for one runway with long jump at the other. Take off boards for long jump at both ends on the other runway
Steeple chase drainage repairs provisional sum	Investigate and repair failed drainage channel & plug to the steeple chase water pit
Sandpit covers	Supplying net weighted sandpit covers x 2
Jump sand pits	Replace 50% top layer of both sandpits with correct grade sand. Takeaway builders sand
Shot put	Carry out remedial works to the shot put landing sector
