Your Membership includes your England Athletics registration fee of £14, a club vest for competition use (you receive this when you first compete for the club in one of our recognised club competitions), all your training fees the entire year (we do not have a track use fee) a personalised RAC barcode card used for registration, and most competition entries will be paid for by the club.
