The club continues to remain in a healthy financial state with an end of year balance of £68,346.00 a profit of £8.9k just slightly down on last years, although this is a nice profit we should be aware that with the possibility of limited income this year through reduced subscriptions, and a falling membership for obvious reasons.

However we have increased our spending in the current Financial year including the purchase of a defibrillator, lots of new equipment, and of course the training of new coaches which is vital for the clubs continuance, and of course more sessions at the track, but I think as soon as restrictions are lifted I am sure numbers will increase.
